Parents of young skaters (not able to get equipment on independently or may require a bathroom break mid lesson) must be available in the arena throughout all skating sessions.
- All Skate Canada member participants up to and including Stage 5 must wear a CSA approved hockey helmet while on the ice. This policy is a minimum Skate Canada standard. Coaches may impose a higher standard.
- Days and times are TBA and schedules are subject to change - The Terrace Skating Club is not responsible for failure to supply ice due to any mechanical defect or failure, strike or walk out, negligence or oversight of employees, natural disaster, or pandemic related incidents.
- The Terrace Skating Club does not assume any responsibility or liability for injury occurring as a result of participation in any TSC program.

## Payment must be made online by credit card. No cash or cheque.

- Sept – Dec regular season figure skating fees are **due by WEDNESDAY JULY 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022** (by midnight) for all Junior to Senior level figure skaters purchasing a package. There will be a \$100.00 late fee added on after this date.
- Jan – March regular season figure skating fees are **due by DECEMBER 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022** (by midnight) for all Junior to Senior level figure skaters purchasing a package. There will be a \$100.00 late fee added on after this date.

## **Junior Plus skaters will register under intermediate/senior for the 2022-2023 skating season due to numbers.**

- Coaching is only included for some sessions; please see Members tab on TSC website.
- Set 1 packages above (A,B) include registration to the TSC seminar September 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
- All Pre Junior to Senior skaters are required to participate in Synchronized Skating.
- Junior skaters must follow the figure skating dress code – see Policies and Procedures.
- Parents must read the Volunteer Policy and know they will need to volunteer time during the season.
